We left you with our last letter asking you to please pray for Lennie Baker to be saved. Lennie came back to our house a few weeks after our last letter and we spent over 3 hours on my front porch going through the scriptures. Then Lennie bowed his head and repented and put his faith in the Lord Jesus Christ in an audible prayer from his own heart! We followed this up with some discipleship Bible studies. When God saved Lennie he was on the verge of divorce and his wife continued that direction and he was forced to move further away. We are staying in touch and I am praying for him to be able to move closer and become a part of our church. Please pray for this.

God allowed us to attend our camp meeting at our sending church, Shiloh Baptist Church in June. I was able to preach on the Culpepper Minute Men. There were many helpful sermon's preached and we were greatly encouraged by them as well as fellowship with friends and meeting new friends. While there a friend asked about our Camp

Meeting in October and I informed him that I did not know if we would have one for I did not see how we could afford it. He informed me that he was coming whether we had a meeting or not. We prayed and choose by faith to have the meeting.

God has used us to minister to many people over the summer. And sent some to help us. Brother Mike Smith had finished the mudding of the sheetrock and with it finished he wanted to texture the ceiling. We needed to paint the newly finished walls and with Br. Smith's advice I went to the Sherwin Williams store to see if we could afford some paint. After learning all I could from the people at the store, as I had never sprayed an interior room before, I asked if they had any discounts for churches. He showed me a 5 gallon bucket of paint and offered it for \$100. This paint is about 4 steps in quality above what we looking at for \$125-\$150 for 5 gallons. They had one more 5 gallon bucket of it which was the exact amount we needed!

It gets better. While prepping to paint I saw some people at the old graveyard up the hill from our building. I try

to go introduce myself when I see people in the graveyard and so I did that morning. There were 5 of them from the Daughters and Sons of the American Revolution and they were repairing old tombstones. As we talked, one lady asked to see the inside of our building. Before they left she and her husband gave us a check for \$500! Which covered the paint and primer and other things needed to paint! We had help from an old friend, Paul Crompton, and his grown daughter, Danielle to paint. Danielle started coming to our services. Work has kept her from services lately but she is watching and interacting on our live stream.

At the beginning of September we were again hit with a huge challenge as my wife and I found ourselves living together alone for the first time since our oldest daughter was born over 38 years ago. Within two hours of this crisis I was on the phone with a missionary friend, Br. Glen Yeager, who himself was in the middle of a great crisis in their ministry. We offered to help them and so that Sunday they came to church. They have been attending our services while getting


ready to move to Mississippi to their new home church. Br. Yeager helped us start live streaming some years ago. He has helped us much with technology while coming as well as his wife contributing to helping and encouraging my wife. Sister Yeager has helped much with decorating including donating many items to the meeting house and to my wife.

Br. Mike Smith came back and textured the ceiling in September just in time for our Camp Meeting in October. We had around 40 in attendance and God provided the finances so that it was all paid for before the meeting was over. We were able to take many to Kings Mountain National Military Park and teach God's involvement in this battle through the Baptist. This battle was the turning point of the Revolutionary War in the favor of the colonist. God sent Br. Derek Vahhoorst to cook for the meeting this year and that turned into a tremendous blessing. God used he and his wife and four little children with my wife and I to set up the tent for feeding. We had never set the tent up with only four adults before and it went up the smoothest of any time we had ever set it up.

One family, the Hardy family, attending our meeting for the second time, had God's divine intervention to get there. They were under a great Satanic attack and God intervened the week before and they were able to make the meeting. This was very important to us as Br. Hardy is a church planter sent out by our sending church and God has led them to move here and work with us in planting churches. We have prayed for this for years. Br. Hardy and I have been talking about this for several months and we are already praying together for God to move in our church and families. They hope to be here by Thanksgiving or shortly after. We are very excited about this ministry opportunity.

We continue to pray for laborers for the harvest here. Thank you for praying for us on this battlefield!
